Sub:- Higher Education Department- Additional Skill Acquisition Programme- Supply of refreshments for ASAP students when classes are conducted both Fore Noon and After Noon - clarification reg

Additional Skill Acquisition Programme being implemented in Higher Secondary Schools and Arts and Science Colleges of the State have two types of sessions being conducted either in parent institutions or Skill Development Centres. Some of the skill courses are having more than 3 Hours of class duration taking in to consideration the requirement of continuous stretch of transaction characteristic of the sector/ skill course. As it became inevitable to conduct Foundation Module classes in SDCs during the vacation / holidays due to various reasons including the shortage of SDE s , similar situation come across where the same student attend longer stretches of ASAP's skill sessions spreading to Fore Noon and After Noon of the same day,

Under these circumstances, it is clarified that supply of refreshments can be made twice a day to ASAP students who are having Foundation/Skill training in forenoon and afternoon sessions on same day limiting the cost to Rs. 15/- per head at a time, abiding to the conditions stipulated in the Government order as well as the circular issued referred as 2nd.

This will have the retrospective effect from 17-11-2012.
